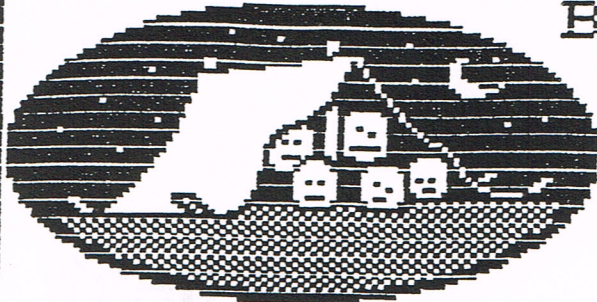

Candy Sale Results

This year's candy sale was a large success. The troop sold an astounding 123 cases of candy for a gross profit of \$2,952. A total of \$534 in commissions was paid to those scouts who sold 3 or more cases. In addition to the commissions, prizes were given to the top 3 sellers. These prizes were free summer camp (\$140 value) for 1st and 2nd place and 3 free campouts (\$40 value) for 3rd place. An outing is being planned for the BRAP patrol which averaged the most sales per scout. The troop's net profit after prizes and commissions is \$2,033.
