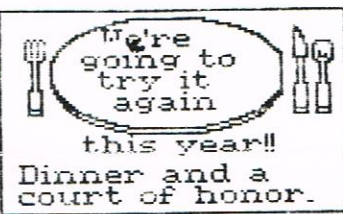

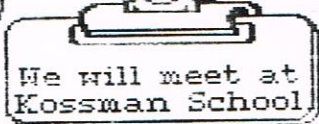
Parents should bring lawn chairs on Saturday evening. Let's hope it doesn't rain like last year.

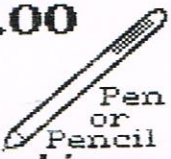
